I attended the CBA Real Estate Section Council ("RESC") meeting on 08/15/23 by Zoom. The following is my report on matters addressed which the CBA Trust and Estate Section Council ("TESC") might find of interest:

Final Tenant Radon Disclosure Form has been approved by the Executive Council. It is now available for purchase, download, and use from the Bar Association.

On June 6, 2023; Governor Polis vetoed House Bill 23-1190, "Affordable Housing Right Of First Refusal." It would have created a right of first refusal for a local government to match an acceptable offer for the sale of a residential or mixed-use multifamily property. The government's right to the purchase would have been contingent on the property being used for long-term affordable housing. The Governor raised concerns that this bill would increase liability and insurance costs. He also found fault in the failure to define the term an "economically substantially identical" offer submitted by the government. He saw this ambiguity as exposing sellers to challenge and chilling real estate transactions in Colorado.

A standing committee of the ABA proposed changes to Model Rule of Professional Conduct 1.16 (Declining or Terminating Representation). The changes would clarify and strengthen the attorney's client due diligence duty. The purpose for the changes is to prevent a lawyers' unwitting involvement in criminal financial activities of a client. The Business Law Section opposed the current proposed changes because it sees the focus shifting too much from protecting clients to assisting law enforcement. The ABA has since passed the changes, and next they go to each of the states.
