1. Approval of Minutes of Prior Meeting

The Minutes of the March 3, 2021, Council meeting were approved unanimously.

2. Chair's Report (Spencer Crona)

Annual Meeting coming up. Update on SB 75 – there are concerns and questions even in its amended form – on its way to the House floor. See legislative update.

3. Secretary/Treasurer Report (Molly Zwerdlinger)

No change to financials. Annual meeting coming up next month.

4. Tax Section Liaison (Georgine M. Kryda)

Legislative update coming in June.

5. Elder Law Section Liaison (Patrick Thiessen)

Elder Law Retreat is August 26-27, maybe some in-person networking. See legislative update.

6. Real Estate Section Liaison (Chad Rounds)

7. Family Law Section Liaison (Kim Willoughby)

Last session was spent dealing with diversity issues. The Section is trying to get someone appointed to District Court who has significant background in family law.

8. Statutory Revisions Committee (Lauren Da Cunha)

UPC 2019 updates is making progress. There was a discussion about common law marriage and whether a subcommittee should be formed - Frank Hill mentioned that this was brought up 5 years ago an many sections of the Bar have different views on it – SRC says that unless Council directs them, they are not going to create a subcommittee – Leia Ursery is going to do background research to see what other states have done to protect communities who may be harmed by removal of common law.

9. Legislative Liaison (Stephen M. Brainerd & Darla Daniel)

See legislative update.

10. Legislative Update (Andy White)

HB 1123 – result of an audit of DHS and APS division – recommendation was a way to improve a line of communication between findings of APS and the courts as a result of the audit– CBA worked to amend it to limit the negative effects of the original bill- has made its way through Senate committee.

SB 75 Supportive Decision Making – proposed by disability rights organizations – Elder Law has identified concerns – there are concerns and questions regarding notice and impaired fiduciary duty – amendments have been adopted in full.

SB 118 – brought by the CCI – pilot program that allows up to 10 counties to exercise greater discretion as it relates to alleged abuse of at-risk adults – CBA is in support of this Bill because it gives some flexibility to CAPS system – does not apply to professional fiduciaries.

CUTC Part 5 and UFIPA both unanimously passed the Senate.

SB 95 – Aligns execution requirements for medical directives – heard by senate judiciary – Steve Brainerd and Carl Stevens worked hard on the hearing. Expected to move quickly through senate.

11. Council Notes (Kristin Dittus)

In between additions. Looking for nominations for Sterling Ambler Award. Article coming up by Georgine. Looking for more articles.

12. Continuing Legal Education & Estate Planning Retreat (Tim Bounds)

Estate planning retreat is virtual. Email was sent for registration. DATE: 04/21/21

I attended the CBA Real Estate Section Council ("RESC") meeting on 04/20/21. It was conducted on Zoom. The following is my report on matters addressed which the CBA Trust and Estate Section Council ("TESC") might find of interest:

Changes to the American Land Title Association (ALTA) standards are being worked on. Have not been updated since 2006. Still waiting on an effective date.

SB 21-242 - RESC votes to support. The bill allows the division of housing within the department of local affairs to use the housing development grant fund for rental assistance, tenancy support service programs, and awarding grants and loans for the purchase of underutilized hotels, underutilized motels, and other underutilized properties. The bill expands those who are eligible to benefit from the rental assistance and tenancy support programs to include individuals experiencing homelessness.

HB-1282 - RESC votes to amend. An AG's priority bill. The bill subjects mortgage servicers to regulation by an assistant attorney general, including the requirements of notification, record keeping, reporting, examinations, inspections, and enforcement. A violation of the requirements is an unfair or deceptive trade practice. Need constructive dialogue with AG's office and other stakeholders. This regulation should be in the realm of DORA not the AG's office.

LPC met and approved revisions to its guidelines. Sections have expressed uncertainty on how LPC decisions are made and how it generally operates. These more detailed guidelines are a response to these concerns. LPC asks that its legislative discussions stay within the CBA to preserve the creditability of the CBA legislative team with legislators.

RESC is exploring creating a more active and permanent legislative liaison position. Currently, the RESC's Secretary is responsible for monitoring legislation and attending LPC meetings. It was mentioned that the Trust and Estate Section has its own permanent statutory revisions committee. The Real Estate Section currently does not have such a standing committee.
