1. Approval of Minutes of the Annual Meeting

The Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Trust and Estate Section meeting were approved unanimously.

2. Approval of Minutes of Prior Meeting

3. Chair's Report (Tim Bounds)

Meetings will be hybrid for now. Susie Harris is the Sterling Amber award winner for this year. Effective June 21, 20212 there are changes to the Probate Procedural Rules and Forms.

9. Statutory Revisions Committee (Dylan Metzner)

Disclosure of Fiduciary Fees, previously approved by Council, is moving forward to be considered for 2022 legislative session. Subcommittee reviewing 2019 revisions to the UTC plans to present in October or November. Leia Ursery is starting a subcommittee to review Common Law Marriage in Colorado. Gordon Williams is proposing an amendment to 15-14-12.

2019 Revisions to the UPC will be presented to SRC in October with a vote in SRC in November. This should provide sufficient time for through review/debate and still meet 2022 legislative timeline.

11. Legislative Update (Andy White)

Legislative session ended June 13th. Internally, LPC will meet monthly from October through December and then weekly January through May. Colorado Uniform Law Commission has not set an agenda yet. Typically meet in Q4 and January.

DATE: 08/18/21

I attended the CBA Real Estate Section Council ("RESC") meeting on 08/17/21. Members participated in person, as well as by Zoom. The following is my report on matters addressed which the CBA Trust and Estate Section Council ("TESC") might find of interest:

Title Standards Table of Contents:

RESC authorized that its Title Standards Committee make appropriate updates to the table of contents for the Title Standards and that the table of contents be published electronically by West Publishing.

Theme for This Year:

The Chair stated the theme this year for the section is "reconnection" with each other which can take many different forms.

Taskforce Appointments:

RESC is making taskforce appointments in advance of the legislative session so the section can be active in the stakeholder meetings already in progress and be proactive instead of reactive in its response to planned legislation involving real estate issues.

Possible Legislation:

#1) The RESC believes that chain of title is the foundation of real estate law and real property rights. It might spearhead legislation to counter the Court of Appeals decision in the *Buffalo Run* case which found that actions affecting real estate do not necessarily need to be strictly remedied if outside the chain of title.

#2) Racial restrictive covenants are void, but the hope is to come up with legislation to try to redact these offensive restrictions, while still preserving the integrity of the public records.

#3) An initial meeting on Property Ownership Confidentiality is set for August 23rd. Andy White stated that Darla Daniel and Steve Brainerd plan to attend for the Trust and Estate Section to cover any trust aspects of this discussion.
