- HB 17-1303:
  - Changes to judicial review commission. Not expected this section would take a position as 1/3 of us our judges.
- HB 17- 1268:
  - Immigration bill, that affects the Criminal Law by changing M2s to a maximum 364 days. The Immigration section will ask LPC to endorse the bill. Jeremy wanted to make sure the Crim Law Section was looped in. Discussion was had. There was not a motion to take a position.
- HB 17-1132:
  - Judicial Recusal bill.
