A. The next Cannabis Law Committee ("CLC" or "Committee") meeting will be held at the same place, on May 4, 2018 at noon.

B. The next topic of discussion was approving the minutes from the last meeting. Mr. Elliot made a motion to approve, pending the change to Carlos's last name, Ms. Killion seconded the motion, no one opposed.

**RESOLVED**, the minutes from the March meeting are approved pending adding "Gonzales" as Carlos's last name.

C. Next the Committee discussed the legislation updates. Those included a new bill to allow budtender managers to sample the product on site; allowing nurses to administer medical marijuana to children at school; and the bill to allow public companies to invest marijuana businesses.

D. The CLC then moved onto a discussing regarding the upcoming CLE on immigration issues and cannabis. Mr. Singh is trying to get Hans Meier, Julie Gonzales, and Maria Montclova to speak at the CLE. Ms. Wittemyer stated that the issue of immigrants being penalized by the federal government for their involvement in the state legal market is an issue that needs more attention in Colorado. Mr. Elliot suggested possibly trying to get this information in the State's "Good to Know" campaign.

E. Finally, Cory (last name unknown) brought up a case regarding preemption of cannabis law in which a county in Oregon is suing the State of Oregon for a federally illegal program. Josephine County v. State of Oregon 1:18-cv-566

Mr. Elliot then moved to adjourn the meeting and Ms. Killion seconded it. The meeting was adjourned at 1:02pm.
