### IMPORTANT

Do you have a firewall or router? It is possible that your firewall may block the stream or that your router may not pass the stream correctly. Try temporarily disabling the firewall to see if the stream works or have your network administrator look into it. Your network administrator may have to check into the router setup as well if it is determined to be the cause of any problems or disruption to receiving the stream.
