He served as Assistant General Counsel at Union Pacific Corporation and its subsidiary, Union Pacific Resources Company, for twenty-three years, in New York City, Fort Worth and Denver. In 1994, he retired from corporate life and re-entered private practice joining his present firm, where his practice focuses on oil and gas

law. He has served as Adjunct Professor of Oil and Gas Law at the University of Denver Sturm College of Law since 2000. Mr. Jones is a former Trustee of the Rocky Mountain Mineral Law Foundation and is a current member of the Colorado Bar Association Board of Governors and a Bar Foundation Fellow. He has been designated as a Colorado Super Lawyer by 5280 Magazine and has been listed in the Best Lawyers in America every year since such publications established an oil and gas category.
