

15-14-719. Acceptance of and reliance upon acknowledged power of attorney. (1) For purposes of this section and section 15-14-720, "acknowledged" means:

(a) purportedly verified before a notary public or other individual authorized to take acknowledgments and

(b) accompanied by an executed "Agent's Acknowledgment," in the following form:

(2) (a) In this subsection (2), "Agent's Acknowledgment form" refers to the form set forth in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section.

(b) The statements in the Agent's Acknowledgment form are not intended to alter the law of this state with respect to any or all of the matters addressed by such statements.

(c) This subsection (2) shall not limit the use of an Agent's Acknowledgment form executed by an agent as evidence of the agent's admissions of the agent's intent, knowledge or understanding with respect to any or all of the matters addressed by the statements in the Agent's Acknowledgment form.

(3) A person that in good faith accepts a purportedly acknowledged power of attorney
