

**NOTICE OF HEARING TO CONSIDER AMENDMENTS TO THE
WORKERS' COMPENSATION RULES OF PROCEDURE, 7CCR 1101-3**

Notice is given of a public hearing to afford all interested persons an opportunity to be heard prior to the adoption of proposed amendments to the Workers' Compensation Rules of Procedure, 7 C.C.R. 1101-3 as described below. The Director of the Division of Workers' Compensation has the authority to promulgate rules pursuant to the Workers' Compensation Act as set forth in C.R.S. sections 8-47-107 and 8-43-304(1.5)(a).

The public hearing will be held in accordance with the provisions of the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act, section 24-4-103, CRS. Any written submissions should be submitted to the Director prior to the hearing on November 10, 2008.

The topic to be considered is:

Rule 7-2: Striking the current Rule 7-2 and promulgating a new updated rule. The purpose of this rule amendment is to set up a standardized process for settling workers' compensation claims and to create a uniform settlement agreement for use by injured workers whether or not they are represented by counsel.

Proposed rule revisions will be available at the Department's website on or before October 2, 2008.
