Any written submissions should be submitted to the Director prior to the hearing on August 7, 2009.

The topics to be considered are:

**Rule 16**

Revisions to language and standard terminology, revisions to or clarification of administrative procedures and requirements necessary to implement the Division Medical Treatment Guidelines and Medical Fee Schedule.

**Rule 18**

Revisions to clarify or update the language of the Medical Fee Schedule; revisions to the medical billing codes systems; update of fees and relative values; revisions to medical requirements, procedures and payments as they relate to the Medical Fee Schedule.

Proposed rule revisions will be available at the Department's website on or before July 1, 2009. Copies of the proposed rules, the proposed statement of basis and purpose, and a regulatory analysis will also be available no later than July 31, 2009, at the Division's Customer Service Office, 633 17<sup>th</sup> Street, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor, Denver, Colorado, or on the website.
