

CBA Meeting Minutes
September 25, 2009

1. Meeting minutes from June 25th were reviewed and approved.
2. Legal Fairs:
 - a. Liz reported that Greeley Legal Fair of August 29th had about 80 people registered – nice size turnout.
 - b. Pueblo – postponed until October 10th, maybe it that date was even too soon. We really need to get down south.
 - c. May look at doing Queen of Peace in January 2010.
3. “Our Courts” – Liz reported that the training of August 8th went well. We are now looking for venues in which to do the presentation.
4. Colorado Lawyer’s Committee & Greeley Task Force – no update.
5. DU Law School – no update.
6. Spanish Legal Directory – The group reviewed the draft of the questions for the survey and revised the order. Liz will update the survey and send to the group before having the CBA send it out. Also, Liz reported that she spoke with Chuck Turner and he indicated he would like the directory to include as many Spanish-speaking attorneys as possible, even if they are non-CBA members.
7. CLEs – Liz will work on these.
8. Developing Legal Resources/Conducting Outreach outside Denver-metro area.
 - a. Liz brought up the fact that there is not much outside the Denver-metro area for the Spanish-speaking community in terms of where and how to find legal information in Spanish. The resources that may be available are typically on the internet, and many Spanish-speaking individuals don’t have access to the Internet or would not know how to find the information.
 - b. Some of the information that is out there in Spanish may also be too long for individuals to read.
 - c. Catherine Chan agreed to contact Azteca America re: doing something similar to Lawline9.
 - d. Bryony Heise and Liz will begin to look at putting together the resources – developing binders to distribute/leave at places when we do legal fairs and/or create small informational brochures targeted at the Spanish-speaking community.
