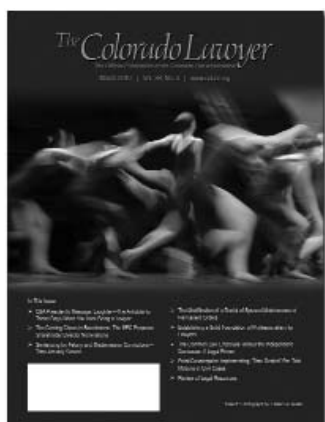
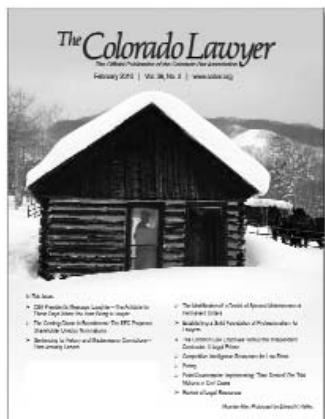


# ATTENTION PHOTOGRAPHERS!

*The Colorado Lawyer* would like to consider your photograph for its cover.



## Photographs Accepted

- ❖ Color photographs of Colorado landscapes, landmarks, and animals (people can appear only as incidentals and must not be identifiable)
- ❖ Color photographs of artwork of Colorado-related scenes created in other media by Colorado artists (e.g., oil paintings/color ink, chalk, or pencil drawings)

## Technical Requirements

- ❖ Vibrant color, high contrast, sharp focus
- ❖ Photographic prints accepted (inkjet/laser prints are not)
- ❖ Digital photos accepted
  - Use the highest quality image setting on your digital camera.
  - Photos must be: at least 5x7 inches, taken at a minimum resolution of 300 dpi; or 8x10 inches at 300 dpi for full-photo cover.
  - Save photos as RGB in TIFF format (.tif). Alternatively, send the original JPEG (.jpg) file directly from your digital camera (please do not resize or make any other alterations).
  - Photos may be enhanced with image-editing software, but details must be included in description.

- ❖ Law-related administrative staff
- ❖ Colorado law students

  - Identify the photographer; include legal affiliation, address, daytime phone number, and e-mail address.
  - Include a brief description of the photograph and a working photograph title; note where and when the photo was taken.
  - Identify equipment, film type, and special techniques (if any) used.

- Interior and exterior color photographs are welcome.
- There are no seasonal restrictions.
