<b>ORDER APPROVING FINAL ACCOUNTING AND DISCHARGING TRUSTEE FROM LIABILITY</b>	

This matter comes before the Court on the *Petition for Discharge of Former Trustee Pursuant to November 9, 2022 Order* (“Petition”) filed by the former trustee of the above trust, [redacted]. The Court, having considered the Petition, court file and applicable rules and law, hereby makes the following findings and enters the following order:

THE COURT FINDS THAT pursuant to this Court’s November 9, 2022 *Order Approving Trustee’s Resignation and Appointing Successor Trustee* (the “Order”) [redacted] was directed to distribute the corpus of the [redacted] (“Trust”), provide all accounting records to the Successor Trustee that the Successor Trustee requested, and upon filing evidence of having done so with this Court, [redacted] (“Beneficiary”) would have 90-days to review the same and file any formal claims regarding [redacted]’s administration of the Trust.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS THAT [redacted] filed evidence with this Court on February 23, 2023 in the form of Trust account statements covering August 9, 2022 through February 23, 2023 that, in conjunction with the accounting filed as Exhibit 3 to [redacted]’s August 10, 2022, *Petition for Approval of Trustee’s Resignation and Final Accounting, and Appointment of Successor Trustee*, constitutes [redacted]’s “Final Accounting”, and evidenced compliance with this Court’s Order.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS THAT Beneficiary had 90-days from February 23, 2023 – or through and including May 24, 2023 – to file claims regarding [redacted]’s administration of the Trust.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS THAT no claims regarding [redacted]’s administration of the Trust were filed by May 24, 2023, and therefore it is appropriate for the Court to both approve [redacted]’s Final Accounting and issue [redacted] a decree of final discharge, fully and finally discharging [redacted] from any and all liability for its service as trustee of the Trust.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT [redacted]’s Final Accounting, collectively consisting of Exhibit 3 to the August 10, 2022 *Petition for Approval of Trustee’s Resignation and*

*Final Accounting, and Appointment of Successor Trustee* and the account statements filed with this Court on February 23, 2023, is hereby **APPROVED**.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED THAT \_\_\_\_\_ is hereby discharged as trustee of the Trust and is released and discharged from any and all liability related to or arising from the performance of its fiduciary duties as trustee of the Trust.
