Each of the 2021-2022 Speciality Bar's representative to the Board of Governors are eligible for appointment to the Executive Council.</p> <p>Any other speciality bar member who will also serve on the Board of Governors for the 2021-2022 year are also eligible. For example, each CBA section has a representative on the Board of Governors. If a speciality bar member was chosen to serve as their section's Board of Governors representative they would be eligible for appointment on the Executive Council.</p>

(Subject to change)</p> <p>Every year the CBA president makes 7 appointments.</p>
CBA Nominating Committee	2 appointments will be made and applicants are requested.	September 1, 2021	October 2021	1 Term	The committee meets in the fall and once in December each year to select the next CBA President Elect and Region VP's.
CBA Investment Committee	1 appointment will be made and applicants are requested.	September 1, 2021	October 2021	December 1, 2021	This Committee is responsible for directing and monitoring the investment management of CBA fund assets according to the CBA Investment Committee Charter, CBA Investment Policy Statement, and Asset Management Agreement, as approved by the Executive Council. The Committee, in accordance with the CBA Investment Committee Charter shall consist of up to six (6) members, including the CBA Executive Director, Deputy Executive Director, and/or other senior financial staff of the CBA, and up to three (3) members appointed by the CBA President. The non-staff positions shall be selected for staggered three-year terms to maintain continuity on the Committee. Members are limited to serving two successive terms.

ABA House of Delegates	2-4 positions available	May 15, 2021	June 2021	2 year Term Term Starts after ABA Annual Meeting in August every year	With more than 400,000 members, the ABA is the largest voluntary professional association in the world. The control and administration of the ABA is vested in the House of Delegates, the policy-making body of the association.  Duties include traveling to designated cities to attend each House meeting, participating in its proceedings, and discharging the House's responsibilities. Delegates are to keep the CBA informed of House actions and matters pending before the House.  The Delegates will travel two times a year to attend the ABA Annual Meeting in August (one to two-day meeting);and ABA Mid-Year Meeting in February (one to two-day meeting) The Delegates also are CBA Board of Governors and will attend the two CBA Board of Governors' meetings each year in May and October/November.  Expenses for travel and a <u>per diem</u> allowance are paid by the CBA for the ABA meetings; expenses are not reimbursed for the Board of Governors meetings.

The Mission of the Access to Justice Commission is to develop, coordinate and implement policy initiatives to expand access to and enhance the quality of justice in civil legal matters for persons who encounter barriers in gaining access to Colorado's civil justice system.  The Commission meets every other month.

The Board of Directors holds four meetings a year, generally on the third Saturday of the months of January, April, August and October

TBD	Fall 2021	3 year term	Colorado Legal Services is a non-profit corporation that has assisted persons with low income and seniors in the State of Colorado for over 85 years. The mission of Colorado Legal Services is to provide meaningful access to high quality, civil legal services in the pursuit of justice for as many low-income persons and members of vulnerable populations throughout Colorado as possible.  The board meets 5 times a year.
