## **El Paso County Court judge finalists selected** *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Fourth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for an El Paso County Court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Larry Martin. The vacancy will occur on June 1, 2020. Nominees Samorreyan Burney and Dennis McGuire, both of Colorado Springs; and Brian Fields of Black Forest were selected in a videoconference meeting on April 3, 2020.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from April 6, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for El Paso County.
