Fourth Judicial District Court Judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Fourth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created pursuant to Senate Bill 19-043, effective Jan. 1, 2020.

Nominees Frances Johnson and Steven Paul, both of Colorado Springs; and William Moller of Woodland Park were selected by the commission on Oct. 2, 2019.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Oct. 3, 2019, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Fourth Judicial District (El Paso and Teller counties).
