Tenth Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new District Court judge*

The Tenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a District Court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Jill S. Mattoon, effective Feb. 8, 2020.

Nominees Priscilla Gartner of Denver, Steven Laman of Lakewood, and Gregory Styduhar of Pueblo were selected by the commission on Dec. 3, 2019.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Dec. 4, 2019, within which to appoint one of the nominees for the position of district court judge for the Tenth Judicial District (Pueblo County).
