Moffat County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Fourteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a Moffat County Court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Sandra Gardner. The vacancy will occur on Aug. 1, 2020. Ryan Hess and Brittany Schneider, both of Craig; and Mariah Poole of Steamboat Springs were selected in a videoconference meeting on July 1, 2020.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from July 2, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Moffat County.
