First Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The First Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Chris Bachmeyer. The vacancy will occur on Nov. 30, 2020. Nominees Amy Cardone and Jason Carrithers, both of Golden; and Crystal Littrell of Arvada were selected by the commission on Nov. 17, 2020.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Nov. 18, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the First Judicial District (Gilpin and Jefferson counties).
