14th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Fourteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Shelley A. Hill. The vacancy will occur on Jan. 12, 2021. Nominees Sandra Gardner of Hamilton, and Matthew Karzen and Erin Wilson, both of Steamboat Springs, were selected by the commission on Aug. 28, 2020.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 31, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Fourteenth Judicial District (Grand, Moffat and Routt counties).
