Adams County Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new county court judge*

The Seventeenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for an Adams County court judgeship created by the retirement of the Hon. Sabino E. Romano, effective Nov. 1, 2020. Nominees Courtney Dinnel of Arvada, Madoche Jean of Westminster, and Brett Martin of Commerce City were selected during a videoconference on Nov. 18, 2020.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Nov. 19, 2020, within which to appoint one of the nominees as county court judge for Adams County.
