18th Judicial District Court judge finalists selected *Governor to appoint new district court judge*

The Eighteenth Judicial District Nominating Commission has nominated three candidates for a district court judgeship created by the retirement on the Hon. Charles M. Pratt, effective Sept. 16, 2019. Nominees Alfredo Hernandez of Parker, and Valeria Spencer and Eric White, both of Centennial, were selected by the commission on Aug. 16, 2019, at the Arapahoe County Justice Center.

Under the Colorado Constitution, the governor has 15 days from Aug. 19, 2019, within which to appoint one of the nominees as district court judge for the Eighteenth Judicial District (Arapahoe, Douglas, Elbert and Lincoln counties).
