- Each artwork must be done on at least 8.5 x 11 paper.
- All mediums accepted. Creativity is awarded. Color is preferred.
- Artwork must be the student's own work; no tracings and no coloring pages from the internet or anywhere else where outlines are already drawn.
- Winners will be announced on Law Day, May 1, 2026.
- Winning artwork will be published in the Colorado Lawyer, and all winners will receive a complimentary copy of the publication.
