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Online Foreclosure Case Management System to be Unveiled in Denver

Beginning in June, foreclosure cases in Denver County will be submitted to the public trustee and administered online.

“Denver will be the first jurisdiction in Colorado to take foreclosure case management and auctions online.” Denver Clerk and Recorder Debra Johnson said. “We believe this will help us better serve our customers – banks, attorneys, individuals and real estate investors.”

In Denver, public trustee functions fall under the auspices of the elected Clerk and Recorder.
