**Call to Order** – Ms. Arnold

- 1. **Introduction of guests and liaisons-** Ms. Arnold asked Chuck Calvin and Geoff Anderson to introduce themselves.
- 2. **Approval of <u>November Minutes</u>** Ms. Arnold asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Ms. Amy Brimah made a motion for approval and Ms. Robin Nolin seconded approval. The minutes were unanimously approved.
- 3. **<u>Financial Report</u>** (\$108,219.09 as of <u>December 31, 2020</u>) Ms. Brimah presented the financials.
- 4. **Chair's Report** Jean Arnold
  - a. CBA Access to Justice Committee Meeting. Ms. Arnold introduced Ryann Peyton, CAMP Director at the CO Supreme Court to speak about the Succession to Service. Succession to Service is pro-bono program that matches lawyers with non-profit legal providers that are available. It is a web-based platform. Ms. Peyton presented the program and thanked Mr. Toft for the opportunity to present.
  - b. Programming Guidelines. Ms. Arnold asked that everyone follow the guidelines attached to the agenda. Please be mindful of the difference between one- hour CLEs and CBA- CLE
  - c. *Fairways at Buffalo Run.* Mr. Meseck informed that the opening brief had just been received and the amicus brief was accepted. He expects a response to the amicus brief in a month or two. Ms. Arnold thanked Mr. Meseck for his and the team's work.

  - e. Salvation Army. The charitable committee looked at different options and chose the Salvation Army because of the housing options provided. The Section donated \$4,000.00 on Colorado Gives Day and it was doubled. Ms. Arnold thanked Mr. Jung for his leadership and all those who contributed.

#### **ACTION ITEMS:**

a. Cannabis Liaison.....Jean Arnold Ms. Arnold asked for discussion about the merits of having a liaison. Ms. Nolan supported have a liaison.

b. Eviction Task Force......Amy Brimah Ms. Brimah recommended the formation of an Eviction Task Force. Ms. Lowery-Graber agreed to chair the committee with Angie Schmitz, Deanne Stodden, and Andy Toft. Mr. White commented that there will also be issues at the federal level.

c. Nominating Committee.....Jean Arnold Ms. Arnold stated that Ms. Brimah will chair the nominating committee along with Erin Clark and Eric Snyder.

d. Amend Bylaws......Melinda Pasquini

Ms. Pasquini explained the changes the CBA is recommending on the application and selfnomination process and the related changes to the bylaws. Ms. Pasquini noted that the diversity section may require additional changes. Ms. Ham notified us that the CBA will have language for diversity for the bylaws. The vote was tabled pending receipt of the CBA language.

Mr. Calvin provided background on the issue related to disclosure issues.

## 6. Legislative and Executive Order Updates

a. Executive Order Update – Andy Toft

Mr. Toft noted discussed issues related to evictions and late payment of rent in the Executive Order 2020 307 and that the Governor's intent was after 1/31/21 there would be no assessment of late fees on rent and that the CDC moratorium on evictions would remain in place.

b. Proposed Legislation- Andy White

Mr. White discussed the Uniform Easement Relocation Act proposed bill will be introduced in February. Others agree in the questioning of the need for the bill. CBA was successful in passing the Uniform Electronic Wills Act, as long as wills are executed in accordance with the new law, they will be able to be remotely notarized. Mr. White anticipates an HOA "transparency" bill. Mr. White also anticipates an ADR related bill. If RESC comes up with a solution to the restrictive race based covenants, Mr. White is ready to push that forward. The Legislature met for a 3 days session and will be adjourned until February 16, 2021 and will likely meet through the end of May, however, they have the option to meet to June.

c. Federal Eviction Relief- Amy Brimah and Andy White

Mr. White and Ms. Brimah requested that any issues related to federal eviction that they come across please send to Amy and Andy.

#### 7. **CBA Title Standards** Catherine Hance and Geoff Anderson

Ms. Hance discussed the proposed bill that has been prepared by the title standard committee. Mr. White does not think that there is a viable path for 2021 for a bill this year. Necessary stakeholder outreach needs to occur and most legislatures have their bills selected and finalized for this year, unless there is an immediate harm, it would be difficult to get through quickly. Ms. Arnold asked Ms. Hance to inform RESC when title standards would like a vote from RESC.
